

# Illinois Integrys, Peoples Gas and North Shore Gas Employees' and Retirees' Dollars for Doers Program

## The Program

Each year, you, like so many company employees and retirees, generously give of your time and talents to the community. The Illinois Dollars for Doers Program can make those worthwhile volunteer hours even more valuable.

The Illinois Dollars for Doers Program donates up to \$100 per year on behalf of employees and retirees who volunteer 20 or more hours in a fiscal year.

## Who Can Participate?

The Illinois Dollars for Doers Program is open to Integrys Energy Group, Integrys Energy Services, Integrys Gas Group, Integrys Business Support, Peoples Gas and North Shore Gas employees and retirees in Illinois.

## Eligible Organizations

If you volunteer for organizations in the categories below, they may be eligible for Illinois Dollars for Doers funds. Organizations need to operate/provide benefit in the company service area where you live or work. They must also be tax-exempt under Section 501(c)3 of the Internal Revenue Code.

### Eligible categories:

- Arts and culture
- Community and neighborhood development
- Human services and health
- Environment
- Schools (Grades K-12)

## Ineligible Organizations

While we are committed to encouraging employees' volunteer efforts, we limit Dollars for Doers grants to the eligible categories listed. We do not provide Dollars for Doers contributions to these types of organizations:

- Civic groups, including fraternal, social, union or veterans organizations
- Religious or political organizations
- Organizations whose philosophy and mission conflict with company positions.

## To Participate

The Illinois Dollars for Doers Program will donate up to \$100 per year to a qualifying nonprofit organization.

Your volunteering must be done on personal time. Board meetings, committee meetings and fundraising projects during your normal work hours are not eligible for Illinois Dollars for Doers.

To request Dollars for Doers funds:

1. Complete Section A on the reverse side of this sheet and mail it to the eligible organization. **The deadline for submitting the Illinois Dollars for Doers form is December 1 of each year.**
2. The nonprofit organization should complete Section B and return the form to the Illinois Dollars for Doers Program coordinator.
3. After receiving the completed form, the program coordinator will verify the eligibility of the organization and the volunteer hours
